DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. For use in Factories, Office Buildings, Schools, Hotels, Restaurants, and Stores.

TOILETS: For most positive results remove water from bowl by forcing water over trap. Squirt stream of minimum 1 ounce over inside surface of bowl. Spread over surface with bowl brush, thoroughly cover entire surface including under rim at water outlets, outer bowl rim, and seat. Concentrate clings to surface and gives time required for chemical action. Add one ounce minimum of Concentrate to water. Swab entire surface with solution. A quick light rinsing removes all adhered Concentrate. Wipe outer rim of bowl and seat with a damp sponge.

URINALS: Squirt stream of Concentrate, minimum 2 ounces on walls. Spread over entire surface with brush, including grooves along side of water outlets. Allow to remain on surface 5 minutes and flush. Remove screen at trap and pour in one ounce of concentrate. Swab inside of pipes.

SEPTIC SYSTEMS: Concentrate will not affect action or performance of septic and chemical systems.
