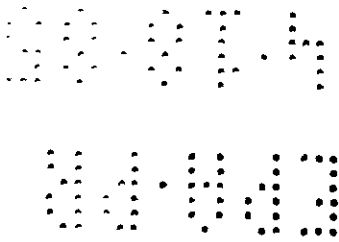

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
