The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

Update the First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- Revise the statement, "For Use In: Hospitals/ motels ... buildings" by deleting the 1. ellipse(...) and "any" and by adding the phrase, "on hard nonporous surfaces: walls, floors, garbage cans, bathroom fixtures, and showers, tubs, glazed tiles, sinks, and glazed porcelain."
- Update the nomenclature for the organism, Trichophyton interdigitalte, to read 2. "Trichopyton mentagophytes." Revise the claim to read, "Effective against Trichophyton mentagrophytes, agent causes Athlete's Foot Fungus, in areas such as locker rooms, shower, and bath areas. Follow disinfection directions."
- Under "Bathrooms," revise the claim "odor causing germs" to read "odor causing 3. bacteria."
- 4. Revise the "Cleaning" Toilet Bowls directions to read "For Disinfection of Toilet Bowls: Remove gross filth prior to disinfection. Empty toilet bowl or urinal. Apply 4 oz. of product into bowl. Throughly brush or swab exposed surfaces especially under the rim.

5. Since your product is making cleaning and deodorizing claims, you must add the following directions with an appropriate heading.

Cleaning and Deodorizing: Apply product to hard nonporous surfaces throughly wetting surfaces. Wipe or allow to air dry.

- 6. Revise the "Disinfecting" directions by stating "Preclean hard nonporous surfaces. Apply product with mechanical sprayer as to thoroughly wet surfaces. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes. Allow to air dry or wipe surfaces with a clean cloth.
- 7. The HIV instructions must be revised as follows:

a) Bold and capitalize the phrase, "KILL HIV-1(AIDS VIRUS) ON PRECLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS."

b) Bold and capitalize the statement, "SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV-1(AIDS VIRUS) ON SURFACES/ OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS."
