

**USE DIRECTIONS:**

**Disinfection**

Use at 2 ounces per gallon. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results, use TROY 1609 DETERGENT DISINFECTANT with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is recommended.

**Sanitization**

If used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items, limit the level of active quaternaries to 200 ppm (2.8 ounces per 5 gallons of water). **RINSE REQUIRED WITH POTABLE WATER.**

This product when used on environmental, inanimate, hard surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon of water, is effective against Influenza A<sub>2</sub>, Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus type 2, and Vaccinia Viruses.
