**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Disinfection**

Use at 2 ounces per gallon. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at the level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results, use TROY 1609 DETERGENT DISINFECTANT with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is recommended.

**Sanitization**

Prevent transmission of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items to the level of contamination to 200 ppm (20 ounces per 100 gallons of water). RINSE AS USUAL WITH POTABLE WATER.

This product when used on environmental, inanimate, hard surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon of water, is effective against Influenza A, Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus type 2, and Vaccinia Viruses.
