

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FACE DISINFECTION AND DEODORIZATION:**

First remove soil deposits from surface to be treated. Hold can six inches from surface and spray until completely wet, allowing the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

**ROOM DEODORIZER AND REFRESHER:**

Point spray upwards to center of room and spray for three seconds.

**MOLD REMOVAL:**

Control mold and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), spray the surface to be treated. Allow to remain wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.
