PRIOR TO SANITIZATION: Remove by a pre-flush, pre-scrape, or cleaner, followed by a pot to application of the sanitizer. **TO SANITIZE:** Either immerse to wet all surfaces thoroughly in a chlorine solution of this product available chlorine solution of this product per each 4 gallons all utensils with potable water.

LAUNDERING IN WASHING MACHINE: Add 1 ounce of this product. This will obtain a 200 ppm available chlorine solution. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Rinse. (For automatic washers before water is added, dilute product in a quart of water laundry is immersed.)

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine. **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in an upright position. Do not store in direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with water. Empty container thoroughly with water and flush by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Do not use, should be diluted with water and not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal.

FOR SANITIZING GLASSES, DISHES, AND SILVERWARE IN
RESTAURANTS:

PRIOR TO SANITIZATION: Remove large food particles by a pre-flush, pre-scrape, or pre-soak treatment. Thoroughly wash all objects with a good detergent or cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse prior to application of the sanitizing solution.
TO SANITIZE: Either immerse for 60 seconds or spray to wet all surfaces thoroughly with a 100 ppm available chlorine solution of this product. To prepare a 100 ppm available chlorine solution add 1 tablespoon of this product per each 4 gallons of water. Rinse all utensils with potable water before reuse.

LAUNDERING IN WASHING MACHINE OR AUTOMATIC WASHER:

Add 1 ounce of this product for each 4 gallons of water. This will obtain a 200 ppm available chlorine residual. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry. Wash. Rinse. (For automatic washers into which laundry is placed before water is added, dilute recommended amount of this product in a quart of water and pour into washer after laundry is immersed.)

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product contains materials that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
