**Protein-polymer mixture:** Add a suitable detergent and dilute with water before application. Mix 1 g agarose, apply a solution containing 1 mg/ml of protein, add 1 ml of water for each dish. After drying, digestions can be carried out using standard disease areas, use 1 volume per portion of agar.
