FOR DISINFECTION Hospitals - Veterinary Clinics - Food Plants - Commercial Freezer - Wash basins, sinks, and tubs. Use 1 oz. of this disinfectant in 5 gallons of water for general cleaning and disinfecting light and moderate soiled surfaces. Heavily soiled surfaces should be cleaned and rinsed before disinfecting. For effective action surfaces must remain wet for at least 5 minutes.

SANITIZING OF NON-FOOD CONTACT SURFACES such as walls, floors, door knobs, counter tops, telephone receivers, door knobs, chairs, toilet seats, bathroom sinks, tubs, and shower stalls, in offices, hotels, industrial and commercial buildings, and non-critical areas of hospitals and nursing homes.
