

**USE DIRECTIONS:**

Use 2 ounces per gallon of water. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at this level.

At 2 ounces per gallon of water, this product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results use SPECTROCIDE with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces.

If used for sanitation of previously cleaned food equipment or other food contact items, limit the level of active quaternary to 200 ppm (2.8 oz. per 5 gallons).

**RINSE REQUIRED USING POTABLE WATER**

For heavy soil or organic matter, a precleaning step is recommended.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

SPECTROCIDE is a concentrated, non-phosphate detergent, disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide and deodorizer. It is specifically designed for Institutional use such as Hospitals, Nursing Homes, and Schools, where housekeeping will be of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross-infection from environmental surfaces. SPECTROCIDE is for use on floors, walls, and other hard surfaces in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Hotels, Public Areas, Industrial Areas and in Institutions. It is excellent for Operating Rooms, Rest Rooms, Nurseries, and Food Service Areas.

When used as directed, SPECTROCIDE is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*.

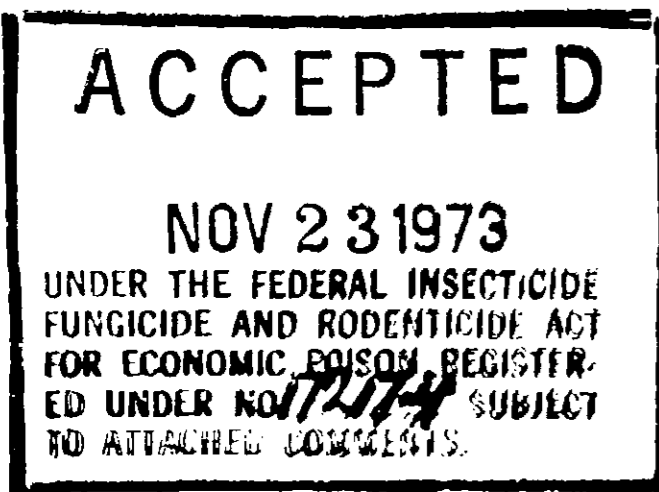
