## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Caution: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Causes eye irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift).
