

## Pathmark Fresh Scent Bleach for a Brighter and Cleaner Laundry and Home

Bleaches Clothes, Floors / Brightens Woodwork  
Whitens Porcelain / Removes scorch stains

### DIRECTIONS

**In the Laundry Tub or Machine:** Use 1 cup of bleach, diluted with water, and add to wash after soap or detergent and water have thoroughly mixed with laundry. For best results use as directed.

**Hand Laundry:** Use 1 tablespoon of bleach per gallon of warm water and add to wash after soap or detergent and water have been thoroughly mixed with laundry. For best results use as directed.

**Diapers:** For deodorizing, disinfecting, and removing stains, use 1 tablespoon of bleach per gallon in diaper pail. Flush out soiled diapers before immersing in diaper pail.

**To Remove Stain and Mildew:** Mix 1/4 cup of bleach in 1 qt. of cold water. Soak 10 to 15 min. - rinse thoroughly. Repeat if necessary.

**To Whiten Yellowed Nylon and Synthetics:** Mix 2 tablespoons bleach, 1 teaspoon household vinegar to 1 gal. of warm water. Immerse 15 to 30 min. - rinse thoroughly. Repeat if necessary.

**Use in Toilet Bowls:** To remove odors, use a few drops of bleach. To remove stains, pour 1/2 cup of bleach into bowl - wash inside surfaces - let stand 1 hour.

**Disinfecting Solution on Thoroughly Cleaned Surfaces:** To prepare a disinfecting solution of 200 parts per million available chlorine, add 1 oz. of Pathmark to 2 gals. of water. Recommended by U.S. Public Health Service for disinfecting restaurants, soda fountains, dairies, etc.

**Do not use on silk, woolsens or leather. Use on white and color fast fabrics only. Important Note: Some wash and wear synthetic fabrics are chlorine bleach retentive. Such fabrics when bleached may tend to yellow. Check labels of all garments before bleaching.**

**As a Household Disinfectant, Cleaner, and Deodorant:** Mix 3 tablespoons or bleach to 1 quart of warm water. Wash item thoroughly, follow with bleach solution, wet or immerse for 5 minutes, rinse well. Use on sink, bath tubs, woodwork, dish cloths, drainboards, enamelware, tile, windows, linoleum, sickroom supplies, garbage cans, refrigerators, ranges, and bathrooms - let dry before use. Do not use on silverware.
