The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable.


However, the next printing of your label delete the phrase "General Classification".

Potassium dimethyldithiocarbamate ..... 10.0%  
INERT INGREDIENTS ..... 90.0%

This product contains 0.87 lb. of active ingredient per gallon and weighs 8.68 lb. per gallon.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**WARNING:** Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, on clothing. Avoid contamination of food. Wear goggles, or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly after handling.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.** *In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If product gets in the eyes, flush immediately with copious amounts of clean, cool water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately. If product is swallowed, call a physician immediately. If patient is conscious, induce vomiting by stroking or tickling the patient's throat or far back on patient's tongue. Emetics such as 2 teaspoonsful (10 mL) of ipecac syrup or 1 teaspoonful (5 mL) of dry mustard in warm water to form a paste or even soap in warm water can be used. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Then have patient drink plenty of milk, gelatin solution, beaten egg whites, flour and water, or nonoily demulcent. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.*

*Note to physician:* Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate gastric lavage.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance contact your Regional Office of the EPA.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A-108 is used in cooling water systems and washdown systems to control microbiological slime. In cooling water systems, add 21.1 to 36.0 fl. oz. of A-108 per 1000 gal. of water to the cooling water. In washdown systems, add 21.1 to 36.0 fl. oz. of A-108 per 100 gal. of water. Repeat treatments every 2 to 4 weeks. The required frequency depends on relative amount of slime problem.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not store more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums should be removed from service and overpack drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed with inert material and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep containers tightly closed. Do not reuse. Do not use if damaged.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Immediately dispose of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or empty container in accordance with Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of in accordance with label instructions, contact your State Pesticide Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

#### CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

- PLASTIC:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then recycle for reuse, reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by other means. If burned, stay out of smoke.
- METAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then recycle for reuse, reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
