

When used as directed, FABRI-SAN Bacteriostatic Laundry Detergent will sanitize fabric during the washing cycle, sanitize fabric during the washing cycle, sanitize the wash water, impart a bacteriostatic finish to Staphylococcus aureus and Escherichia coli and will leave a self-sanitizing residue on laundered fabrics in the presence of high humidity or moisture.

USE DIRECTIONS: Add 3/4 to 1 cup (120 grams) of FABRI-SAN Bacteriostatic Laundry Detergent at the beginning of the wash cycle to a standard (12 gallon) wash load to launder 10 pounds of dry fabric. Do not use this product with other soaps or detergents since such mixtures may destroy the anti-bacterial properties of this product. Cationic softeners may be used in the final rinse without adversely affecting the biological performance of this product.

SUDS SAVER: For washing machines equipped with suds saver cycles, use an additional 3/4 to 1 cup of this product each load of wash.
