

#### SHAKE BEFORE USE

#### FOR USE ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS, INDOOR AND OUTDOOR:

Peperomia, Spirea, Philodendron, African Violet, Euonymus, Sedum, Ferns, Crabapple, Rose, Wisteria.

When sprayed directly on insects, this product kills sucking insects: Aphids, Spider Mites, Leaf Hoppers, Whiteflies and Mealybugs. Kills chewing insects: Japanese Beetles and Southern Army Worms.

#### FOR INDOOR PLANTS:

Spray both upper and lower surface of leaves from a distance of 12-14 inches until visibly wet. Repeat as needed.

#### FOR OUTDOOR PLANTS:

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Avoid using in hot, bright sunshine. Use slow sweeping motion, holding the dispenser approximately one foot from foliage. Spray both upper and lower leaf surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.
