This spray is especially designed for use in cafes, restaurants, food storage warehouses, flour mills, meat packing plants and the like. (EPA Inspection Division Memorandum No. 52 - Insect Sprays) This spray is designed for use in either fogging equipment or hand sprayers.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats: Close room and discharge mist vigorously in all parts of room, using 1 1/2 to 2 ounces for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Leave room closed for at least ten minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as needed.

Fleas (Infesting Premises): Remove and destroy animals' bedding and spray sleeping quarters freely, forcing the spray into all cracks in the floor and about the rooms. Repeat when re-infested.

Roaches, Waterbugs: Apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, and in all places where roaches and waterbugs infest, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat the operation as often as necessary.

Clothes Moths: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Interior surfaces of storage containers such as closets, chests and trunks should be sprayed regularly. The treatment should be repeated every 30 days unless the articles are stored in moth tight containers.

Granary Weevil, Rice Weevil, Confused Flour Beetles, Rust Red Flour Beetle, Cigarette Beetle and Drug Store Beetle: Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect runways and hiding places at the rate of 1 gallon of this material to 1000 square feet of area, or to the point of runoff. Repeat when necessary.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place away from water supplies.
