DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

KITCHEN:

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ cup EXCEL AC 80 per gallon of water for cleaning stove surfaces, sinks, countertops and appliances. Cleans and deodorizes.

BATHROOM:

Cleans and deodorizes bathtubs, shower stalls, sinks and exterior toilet bowl surfaces. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ cup EXCEL AC 80 per gallon of water for cleaning bathtubs, shower stalls and sinks. Add $\frac{1}{4}$ cup full strength EXCEL AC 80 to deodorize toilet bowls.

LAUNDRY:

As a detergent supplement, add 1 cup EXCEL AC 80 to your usual soap or detergent to leave your laundry fresh smelling and extra clean. Heavily soiled areas such as shirt collars, should be pre-treated with full strength AC 80 before laundering.

DIAPERS:

Soak soiled diapers in water containing $\frac{1}{4}$ cup AC 80 per gallon. Reduces odor and improves laundering.

NURSERY:

Washing with $\frac{1}{4}$ cup AC 80 per gallon of water will leave baby's crib and toys clean and sanitary. Wipe clean with water.

PET CARE:

Lather animal with soap first. Then wash using 3 tablespoons AC 80 per gallon of water. Keep out of pets eyes. Rinse well. Removes animal odors.

WORKSHOP:

For cleaning paint brushes, flush well with $\frac{1}{2}$ cup AC 80 per pint of water immediately after use. To soften hard brushes, soak in full strength AC 80.

AUTOMOBILES AND BOATS:

Apply full strength to whitewalls and chrome, scrub and rinse. For boats, use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup AC 80 per gallon of water for topside and bottom cleaning. To reduce head and hold tank odors, add 1 ounce AC 80 to toilet bowl.

CLOSETS, ATTICS, BASEMENTS:

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ cup AC 80 per gallon of water for walls and floors.

FARMS: (Livestock Shelters)

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ cup AC 80 per gallon of water to reduce odors and leave shelter clean and sanitary. For barns, remove animals and feed. Remove litter and droppings from all surfaces. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding devices. Apply recommended AC 80 solution to surfaces to be treated. Ventilate premises. Replace animals and equipment after treated surfaces are dry or have been rinsed. Rinse watering and feeding devices thoroughly with potable water.
