

The following requirements or revisions apply to the label which was accepted with this registration notice:

1. The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Reg. No. 18305-11.
2. The confirmatory use-dilution data @ 1:256 for hospital disinfection are acceptable and have been assigned EPA Accession No. 254751. However, the confirmatory sanitizing data @ 1:832 are reported as providing "99.99%" kill instead of 99,999%, as required. This discrepancy must be clarified.
3. The labels which will be used for this product in channels of trade must reflect these revisions.
4. Five copies of the finished printed labels, as defined in the A-79 Enclosure, must be submitted to the Agency before the product is released for shipment to comply with PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982.
5. The finished printed labels must comply with the general labeling requirements of Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the labels.

Hand Sanitizing — In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. **San-I-Dyne** per 5 gal. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

Retort Cooling Water — For canning operations — add 1 oz. **San-I-Dyne** per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization — 1 oz. **San-I-Dyne** per 10 gallons of drinking water.

Shoe Bath Sanitizer — To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of **San-I-Dyne** for 30 seconds prior to entering area.

Udder Wash — The udders, flanks and teats of dairy cows can be sanitized by washing with a solution of 1 oz **San-I-Dyne** in 5 gallons of warm water. **No potable water rinses required** Use a fresh towel for each cow. Avoid contamination of sanitizing solution by dirt and soil. Do not dip used towel back into sanitizing solution. When solution becomes visibly dirty, discard and provide fresh solution.
