Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner

Apply **San-I-Dyne LF** to a pre-cleaned surface by dipping. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surfaces wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 2 minutes. Fresh use solution becomes visibly dirty.

When circulating sanitizer solution through CIP system, allow

Sanitizing — Meat, dairy and food processing equipment and surfaces by scraping, or mopping. Clean surfaces with detergent water. Sanitize surface with 25ppm San-I-Dyne LF.

Food and Beverage Sanitization Procedures

Beverage Plants: Thoroughly rinse bottling and pre-mix dispensing equipment with 25 ppm solution (refer to use solution chart). Rinse with 25 ppm solution from equipment with potable water. When circulating through system well with water, flush with 25 ppm solution. Drain.

Bottles and Cans: Proportion into the final rinse, or rinses, of 12.5 ppm titratable iodine (see solution chart).

Storage Tanks: After cleaning, use a 25 ppm solution for sanitizing. Use solution can be applied by spraying or can be used in circulation systems. No water rinse is required after sanitizing.

Equipment in Poultry, Meat, Rabbit, Egg Processing Plants, Fresh Produce: To clean equipment, scrub surfaces with a mop, brush, sponge with potable water. For sanitizing previously cleaned surfaces, flush, or with a clean sponge. Thoroughly wet surface and rinse is required.

Milk, Citrus and Ice Cream Processing Plants: San-I-Dyne LF sanitizing spray (12.5 ppm to 25 ppm titratable iodine) on walls to reduce or eliminate odors in the processing area. Use on filling equipment which is frequently associated with condensation on equipment. 25 ppm helps prevent milk stone formation on equipment.

Follow the state and local health authority recommendations.
