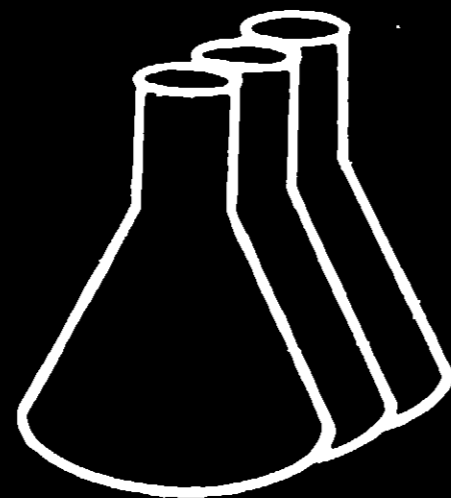

Petroleum Distillate	98.10%
N-Octyl Bicycloheptene Dicarboximide	1.00%
Technical Piperonyl Butoxide	0.60%
Pyrethins	0.30%
*Equivalent to 0.48% (butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.12% related compounds.	

This is a highly concentrated contact insecticide designed especially for use in thermal fog generators, as Dyna Fog for smoke fogging or Atomister or Challenger as a wet mist vapor. For use in Supermarkets, Bottling Plants, Bakeries, Food Processing Plants, Restaurants, Meat Processing or Storage Plants, Flour Mills, Dairies, Canneries, wherever food is processed or served. FOR CONTROL of flying insects as flies, mosquitoes, gnats, fruit flies and love bugs. FOR CONTROL of crawling insects as fleas, roaches, silverfish, Indian flour moths, exposed adult stages of meal and grain moths and spiders.

DIRECTIONS

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the LL-9 Fogging Concentrate in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Thoroughly clean area to be fogged. Sweep all cracks and crevices. Remove all accumulated dirt and trash.

SMOKE FOGGING: For control of flying insects, fog 1 pint of LL-9 Fogging Concentrate per 32,000 cubic feet of space. For control of crawling insects, spray all cracks and hidden surfaces around sinks, equipment and food storage areas. Contact the insects with the wet fog whenever possible.

WET MIST VAPOR: For control of flying insects, use 3/4 ounce of LL-9 Fogging Concentrate per 1,000 cubic feet of space. For control of crawling insects, spray all cracks and hidden surfaces around sinks, equipment and food storage areas. Contact the insects with wet coarse spray whenever possible. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy all fallen insects. Repeat as needed.

CAUTION

Do not pour, store or use near open flame or fire. Avoid contamination of foods. Do not dispense more than 1 gallon of LL-9 Fogging Concentrate into 50,000 cubic feet. Harmful if swallowed.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to Lee Chemical Corp. or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place away from water supplies.
