

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazard to Human and Domestic Animals

WARNING

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Avoid eye contact. If contact occurs, get eyes or skin promptly and thoroughly washed. Avoid contact with contaminated clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with large quantity of water for at least 15 minutes. For eye contact, flush eyes with water and wash contaminated clothing.

If swallowed, drink plenty of water and induce vomiting with two or three glasses of water. If swallowed, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol consumption.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use as directed on the label with water. Do not use in food preparation areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- 1. PROHIBITIONS**
All prohibitions on the label must be followed.
- 2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**

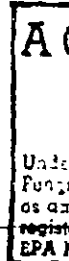

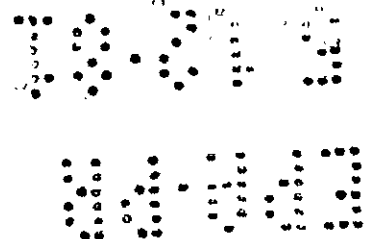
