At 2 ounces per gallon dilution Mountain Mint effectively kills against the organisms salmonella, cholera, typh, staphylococcus aureus and E. coli.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
 It is a violation of Federal law to use Mountain Mint in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DISINFECTION**  
 To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces apply solution with mop, cloth, or sponge so as to wet surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

**DILUTION RATES**  
 General disinfection—use 2 ounces of Mountain Mint per gallon of water.  
 Hospital disinfection—use 2 ounces of Mountain Mint per gallon of water.

**SANITIZATION**  
 To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, prepare 200 ppm active quatary Mountain Mint solution by adding 2 ounces Mountain Mint to 3 1/2 gallons of water. Portable water use is required.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
 Open dumping is prohibited.  
 Do not reuse empty container.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticides that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticide or buried in a safe place.

**Container Disposal:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**WARNING**

Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with water for 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or large quantities of water.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN**

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.
