

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.
Note: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. Do not store in areas with large quantities of water. Product or residues that cannot be removed with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer. Do not reuse empty containers or place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or equipment.

SWIMMING POOL WATER DISINFECTION: For a new pool or spring water, add ACCO Liquid Chlorinating Concentrate Solution-L to yield 5 to 10 ppm available chlorine (See table of proportions). Check the level of available chlorine with a test kit. Maintain pool water pH to between 7.2 to 7.6. Adjust and maintain the pH between 50 to 100 ppm.

To maintain the pool, add manually or by a feeder device ACCO Liquid Chlorinating Concentrate Solution-L to yield an available chlorine residual, between 0.6 to 1.0 ppm (See table of proportions). Stabilized pools should maintain a residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm. The pH, available chlorine residual and alkalinity of the water frequently will vary. Frequency of water treatment will depend upon temperature and number of bather days, or as necessary, superchlorinate the pool to yield 5 to 10 ppm available chlorine. Check the level of available chlorine with a test kit. Do not reenter pool until the residual is between 1.0 to 3.0 ppm. (See table of proportions).

At the end of the swimming pool season or when water is to be drained from the pool, be allowed to dissipate from treated pool water before discharge. Do not discharge within 24 hours prior to discharge.

WINTERIZING POOLS: While water is still clear & clean, apply ACCO Liquid Chlorinating Concentrate Solution-L, while filter is running, obtain a 3 ppm available chlorine residual (See table of proportions), as determined by a suitable test kit. Cover pool, prepare for winter by following manufacturer's instructions.

DISINFECTION OF DRINKING WATER (PUBLIC SYSTEMS): (See table of proportions). Prepare a 10 ppm solution. Bath feeding this solution with a hypochlorinator. Maintain a chlorine residual of at least 0.2 ppm and no more than 0.6 ppm in the distribution system. Check water frequently with a chlorine test kit. Bacteriological testing should be conducted at a frequency no less than that prescribed by the National Sanitation Water regulations. Contact your local Health Department for further details.

LAUNDRY SANITIZERS: Commercial Laundry Sanitizers: Use as directed. Should be spun dry prior to sanitization. Thoroughly mix sufficient proportion.
