

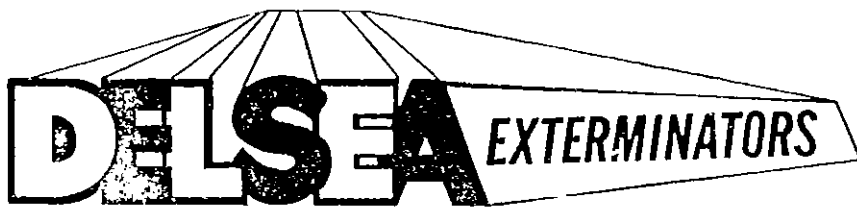

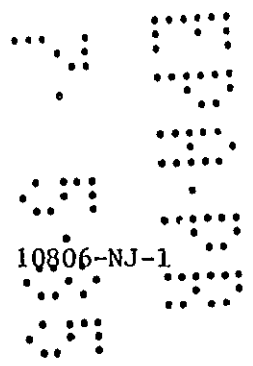

Hazards to Humans
(and Domestic Animals)

CAUTION

Do not install directly over any food handling or dispensing area. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons, are confined. Cover fish bowls when in use.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.

Disposal: Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

To Install: Place dispenser three feet (3 ft.) from exposed food. Install at a distance of seven feet (7 ft.) from the floor and where air currents will carry spray throughout room. One unit will treat up to 6,000 cubic feet of air space (a room 30 x 20 x 10) for 30 days, 24 hours a day.

To Operate: Remove protective cap and place can in dispenser. Turn on dispenser. The automatic dispenser will dispense 100 mg. of insecticide every 15 minutes. Its effectiveness will be noticeable one hour after activation.
