

Enclosed is a stamped copy of the label you submitted.

At the next printing of labels no longer than 6 months from the date of this letter, submit a new Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) which includes certified limits, percent by weight, and upper and lower limit.

The lower limit must be at or above the level of active ingredients declared in the active ingredient statement on the label. Since there is some loss of active ingredients when the product is in storage for a year you must either change the CSF to reflect a 5 percent increase in the amount of pyrethrins used to prepare this product or the amount on the label must be reduced to the amount that is expected to be present after a year's storage. This must be done within 6 months of the date of this letter.

Hazards to Humans (and Domestic Animals)

CAUTION: Do not install directly over any food handling or dispensing area. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined. Cover fish bowls when in use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.

Disposal: Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

To Install: Place dispenser three feet (3 ft.) from exposed food. Install at a distance of seven feet (7 ft.) from the floor and where air currents will carry spray throughout room. One unit will treat up to 6,000 cubic feet of air space (a room 30' x 20' x 10') for 30 days, 24 hours a day.

To Operate: Remove protective cap and place can in dispenser. Turn on dispenser. The automatic dispenser will dispense 100 mg of insecticide every 15 minutes. Its effectiveness will be noticeable one hour after activation.
