Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.

trash collection.

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To Install: Place dispenser three feet (3 ft.) from exposed food. Install at a distance of seven feet (7 ft) from the floor and where air currents will carry spray throughout room. One unit will treat up to 6,000 cubic feet of air space (a room 30x20x10) for 30 days, 24 hours a day.

To Operate: Remove protective cap and place can in dispenser.

Turn on dispenser. The automatic dispenser will dispense 50 mg. of insecticide every 15 minutes. Its effectiveness will be noticeable one hour after activation.
