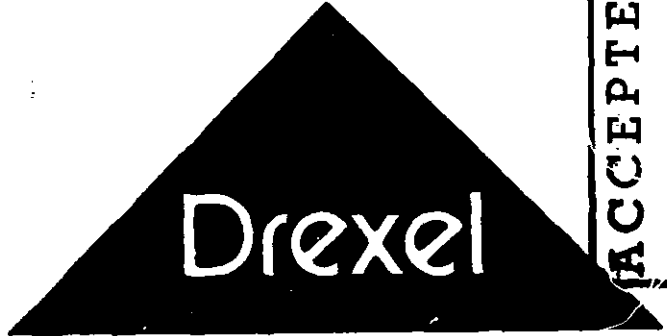

**CAUTION:** Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe dust or mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or drinking. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.  
**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**  
**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
**IF SPLASHED IN EYES:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.  
**IF SPILLED ON SKIN:** Immediately remove contaminated clothing, INCLUDING SHOES, and wash skin with soap and plenty of water. If irritation develops, send for a physician.  
**IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air.  
**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**  
This pesticide is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance contact your Regional Office of EPA.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**  
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. No end use for this product other than manufacturing is intended or implied by this label. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products. For formulation into end-use pesticide products for the following uses:  
Terrestrial, food uses on: Corn, sorghum, macadamia nuts, pineapple, sugar cane  
Terrestrial, nonfood crop uses on: Christmas tree plantations, turf grasses for sod production, conifers, guava, proso millet.  
Terrestrial, noncrop uses on: Fallow land, roadsides, fence rows, highway medians and shoulders, railroad right-of-way, industrial sites (lumberyards, tank farms, etc.), and in noncrop areas on farms, such as around buildings, equipment and fuel storage areas, along fence and lanes, recreational area grasses, and rangeland.  
Domestic Outdoor uses on: Lawns, turf grasses.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
**STORAGE:**  
Storage should be under lock and key and secure from access by unauthorized persons and children. Storage should be in a cool, dry area away from any heat or ignition source. May be ignited by heat or open flame.  
Do not stack over 2 pallets high. Move bags carefully so as not to tear or puncture. Do not move containers from one area to another unless they are securely sealed. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not allow material to become wet or store in a damp, humid area. Keep away from any puncture source. Avoid storage near water supplies, food, feed, and fertilizer to avoid contamination. Store in original container only. If the contents are leaking or material is spilled, follow these steps:  
1. Collect and place in suitable containers for disposal.  
2. Wash area with water and soap to remove remaining pesticide.  
3. Follow washing with clean water rinse.  
4. Do not allow run off to enter sewer or contaminate water supplies.  
5. Dispose of waste as indicated below:  
**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.  
**Container Disposal: Bags**—completely empty bags into formulation equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. **Fiberdrums with liners**—Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into formulation equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.
