Refer to Technical Bulletin for formulating and other information. This technical product may be formulated into end-use products solely for the uses listed below:

Treatment of seeds for the following agricultural crops: Barley, Corn, Oats, Rye, Sorghum, and Wheat.

Dust formulations made from this MUP are for on-farm treatment of Corn and Sorghum seeds only.

Liquid formulations made from this MUP are for commercial or on-farm seed treatment for Barley, Corn, Oats, Rye, Sorghum and Wheat with a closed transfer system only.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on this label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Storage should be under lock and key and secure from access by unauthorized persons and children. Storage should be in a cool, dry area away from any heat or ignition source. Do not stack over 2 pallets high. Do not move containers from one area to another unless they are securely sealed. Keep containers tightly sealed when not in use. Do not allow material to become wet or store in a damp, humid area. Keep away from any puncture source. Avoid storage near water supplies, food, feed and fertilizer to avoid contamination. 2. Wash area with soap and water to remove remaining pesticide.
3. Follow washing with clean water rinse.
