### Statement of Practical Treatment

**IF SWALLOWED:** Induce vomiting by placing finger on back of throat. Call a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and plenty of water. If irritation develops get medical attention.  
**IF IN EYES:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation develops get medical attention.  
**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Carbaryl is a moderate to strong cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Do Not Use PAM (pyridostigmine bromide) as an antidote.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.** Avoid Breathing of Spray. Do Not Take Internally. Avoid Contact with Skin and Eyes. Wear long-sleeved work clothing. Change to clean clothing daily. Wash hands and face before eating. Wash thoroughly after handling.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Avoid contamination of food, feed, water supplies, streams, and ponds during application or when cleaning equipment. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. May kill shrimp and crab.

**BEE CAUTION** — May kill honeybees in substantial numbers. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops.
