Terrestrial, food use on: alfalfa, almonds, apples, apricots, asparagus, bananas, beans, beets, birdfoot trefoil, blackberries, blueberries, boysenberries, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, celery, cherries, chestnuts, chinese cabbage, citrus fruits, clover, collards, corn (field, pop, sweet), cotton, cowpeas, cucumbers, dandelions, dewberries, eggplant, endive, fava beans, flax, grapes, grass (including pastures and rangeland), horseradish, kale, kohlrabi, lentils, lettuce, loganberries, sugar maple (saps), melons, millet, mustard (greens), nocturnes, okra, olives, parsley, parsnip, peaches, peanuts, pears, peas, pecans, peppers, pistachio nuts, plums, (fresh prunes), potatoes, prickly pear cactus (pods and fruit) (Special Local Need Use Only), pumpkins, radishes, raspberries, rutabaga, saffron, sorghum, soybeans, spinach, squash, strawberries, sugar beets, sunflowers, sweet potatoes, Swiss chard, tomatoes, turnips, walnuts, and wheat.

Greenhouse, food use on: Refer to the crops listed for terrestrial food use.

Greenhouse, non-food use on: ornamental plants.

Domestic outdoor use on: ornamental trees, ornamental woody shrubs, ornamental herbaceous plants, lawns and turf, pet sleeping quarters, domestic dwellings, and garbage cans.

Forest use on: Christmas tree plantations, forest trees, recreational areas and parks, shelterbelt plantings.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS:

Storage should be under lock and key and secure from access by unauthorized persons and children. Storage should be in a cool, dry area away from any heat or ignition source. Avoid storage at high temperatures. Do not stack over 2 pallets high. Move containers by handles or cases. Do not move containers from one area to another unless they are securely sealed. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Keep away from any puncture source. Avoid storage near water supplies, food, feed and fertilizer to avoid contamination. Avoid contamination with acids or alkalis. Store in original containers only. If the contents are leaking or material is spilled, follow these steps:

1. Collect and place in suitable containers for disposal.
2. Wash area with water and soap to remove remaining pesticide.
3. Follow washing with clean water rinse.
4. Do not allow runoff to enter sewer or contaminate water supplies.
5. Dispose of waste as indicated below.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Fiber drums with liners: Completely empty line, by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment.
