

Precautionary Statement

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

D-264 Captan Seed Protectant gives temporary protection of germinating seed and seedlings of corn, peas, soybeans and beans (lima, snap, white and kidney) from injury by seed corn maggots and seed corn beetles and gives temporary protection to seed from seed-borne and soil-borne fungi which cause seed decay and seedling blights.

This product contains graphite to assist in accurate planting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CORN: Use 6 oz. (3 level cups) per bushel corn seed. Apply to seed as planter box is being filled. Stir with paddle or lath so that each seed is coated with seed protectant. If temperature is high and soil moisture is low reduce dosage to one-half especially for mid-season planting. DO NOT USE BARE HANDS. Excess product flows with the seed into the furrow giving additional protection against soil-borne diseases.

PEAS, SOYBEANS AND BEANS (lima, snap, white and kidney): Mix 3 oz. (1½ level cups) per bushel of seed in the planter box as a seed treatment prior to planting. Follow mixing instructions as above.

D-264 Captan Seed Protectant may be applied over an approved fungicidal seed treatment.

Under some circumstances D-264 Captan Seed Protectant may affect the rate of seeding. It is necessary for the user to check planting rate frequently to assure himself that the desired planting rate is being obtained.
