Dear Registrant:

The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments listed on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

SERIOUS ERROR(S) ON SUBMITTED LABELING:

EPA has determined that one or more of the errors on the labeling you submitted to the Agency is categorized as "serious" as defined in PR Notice 93-11. In general, serious errors are those that may create a potential for harm to workers, handlers, other persons, or the environment; or those that prevent the achievement of the basic goals of the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) or FIFRA.

The following specific comments pertain to your WPS labeling submission concerning the product cited above:

The requirement under the heading "Personal Protective Equipment" must state: "Applicators and other handlers must wear:". Cross out your lead-in statement and replace it with correct one. EXCEPTION: If you have an entirely separate PPE section specifying what "Mixers and loaders must wear", the requirement under the heading "Personal Protective Equipment" must state: "Applicators and other handlers (other than mixers and loaders) must wear:". Cross out your lead-in statement and replace it with the correct one.

Add the following User Safety Recommendation to the label in the location shown in Section A on Part 1 of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7: "Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing."

Add the following User Safety Recommendation to the label in the location shown in Section A on Part I of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to P. Notice 93-7: "Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."

The apron requirement for "mixers and loaders" in the "Personal Protective Equipment" section on your proposed labeling is missing or incorrect. Remove the incorrect requirement (if any) and add "Chemical-resistant apron when mixing or loading" under "Mixers and loaders must wear:". The exact location is shown in Sections A and C on Part I of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7.

Original Submission

The respirator requirement for "mixers and loaders" in the Personal Protective Equipment" section on your proposed labeling is missing or incorrect. Remove the incorrect requirement (if any) and add "Dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C)" under "Mixers and Loaders must wear:". The exact location is shown in Sections A and C on Part 1 of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three A to PR Notice 93-7.A D/M respirator is required as PPE for mixers/loaders.

Add "Organophosphate" to your label in one of the locations shown in Section E on Part 2 of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7.

Remove the statement "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application." from its current position within the Agricultural Use Box and place it above the Agricultural Use Box.

The wording in the first two statements in the Non-Agricultural Use Requirements box on your proposed label is incorrect. Remove the incorrect statements and replace them with the following: "The requirements in this box apply to uses of this product that are NOT within the scope of the Worker Protection Standard for agricultural pesticides (40 CFR Part 170). The WPS applies when this product is used to produce agricultural plants on farms, forests, nurseries, or greenhouses."

Correct the typographical errors circled on your proposed label.

SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS

CORN: Use 5 ozs. (3 level measuring cups) per bushe! corn seed. Apply to seed as planter box is being filled. Stir with paddle or lathe so that each seed is coated with seed protectant. If temperature is high and soil moisture is low reduce dosage to one-half, especially for mid-season planting. DO NOT USE FARE HANDS. Excess product flows with the seed into the furrow giving additional protection against soil-borne diseases.

SOYBEANS: Mix 3 ozs. (1-1/2 level measuring cups) per bushel of seed in the planter box as a seed treatment prior to planting. Follow mixing instructions as above.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS: Storage should be under lock and key and secure from access by unauthorized persons and children. Storage should be in a cool dry area away from any heat or ignition source. Do not allow storage in a damp or humid area. Do not stack bags over 2 pallets high. Move bags carefully so as not to tear or puncture. Do not move from one area to another unless they are securely sealed to prevent dust from escaping. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Keep away from any puncture source.
