

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captan 25 SEED PROTECTANT is especially formulated for treatment of soybean seed for the control of seed and soil-borne diseases, including damping-off and seed decay organisms, and seedling blights, and is prepared for use directly in the planter box, thereby eliminating additional seed handling to have seed treated.

This material provides adequate coverage of seed and any excess flows with the seed into the furrow, giving additional protection against soil-borne diseases.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and separately launder clothing before reuse.

Mixers/loaders when mixing and loading this product must wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and chemically resistant apron.

A dust mask must be worn when mixing and loading this product.

AFTER WORK: Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with captan must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

Do not use treated seed for food, feed or oil purposes.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

SOYBEANS: Use CAPTAN 25 SEED PROTECTANT at the rate of 5 oz. per 100 lb. seed as a planter box treatment, or as follows:

PLANTER BOX RATES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Size of Platner Box

Number of 1 oz. Scoops per planter box 2 heaping scoops

4 heaping scoops

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS: Storage should be under lock and key and secure from access by unauthorized persons and children. Storage should be in a cool dry area away from any heat or ignition source. Do not allow storage in a damp or humid area. Do not stack bags over 2 pallets high. Move bags carefully so as not to tear or puncture. Do not move from one area to another unless they are securely sealed to prevent dust from escaping. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Keep away from any puncture source. Avoid storage near water supplies, food, feed and fertilizer to avoid contamination. Avoid contamination with acids and alkalies. Store in original containers only. If the contents are leaking or material is spilled follow these steps:

- 1. Collect and place in suitable containers for disposal.
- 2. Wash area with water and soap to remove remaining pesticide.
- 3. Follow washing with clear water rinse.
- 4. Do not allow run off to enter sewer or contaminate water supplies.
- 5. Dispose of waste as indicated below:
