
The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you make the following labeling changes before you ship product:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Do not take internally. Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and the grass is dry. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Do not use treated area or clippings from treated area for feed or forage.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Use only as directed on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Read these entire Directions for Use and Conditions of Sale before using Drexel DYLOX 5% Granular Insecticide.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of sod webworms and white grubs on lawns or ornamental turf only. Do not use on crops used for food or forage. Use only according to label directions. Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS

ORNAMENTALS (Lawn and Ornamental Turf)

Sod webworms (lawn moths) - Apply 2.5 lbs. of DYLOX 5% Granular uniformly over 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn or turf area with any suitable lawn spreader that can be accurately calibrated. For best results, mow the lawn and rake dead grass from damaged spots before applying. After the granules are uniformly applied, water the lawn using 15 to 30 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. Do not water again for at least 3 days. Repeat application as necessary at one to three week intervals. In most areas, the first of these applications should be made in May or June. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station Specialist for more specific information regarding timing of application.

White Grubs - Apply 3.25 lbs. of DYLOX 5% Granular uniformly over 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn or turf area with any suitable lawn spreader that can be accurately calibrated. For best results, mow the lawn and rake dead grass from damaged spots before applying. After the granules are uniformly applied, water the lawn using 15 to 30 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. Do not water again for at least 3 days. Repeat application as necessary at one to three week intervals. In most areas, the first of these applications should be made in May or June. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station Specialist for more specific information regarding timing of application.

HOUSEHOLD STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal (except household): Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal (except household): Do not use container in connection with food, feed, or drinking water. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or material spilled for any reason or cause, carefully sweep material into a pile. Refer to Precautionary Statement on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled material. Dispose of pesticide as directed above. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.
