FIRST AID

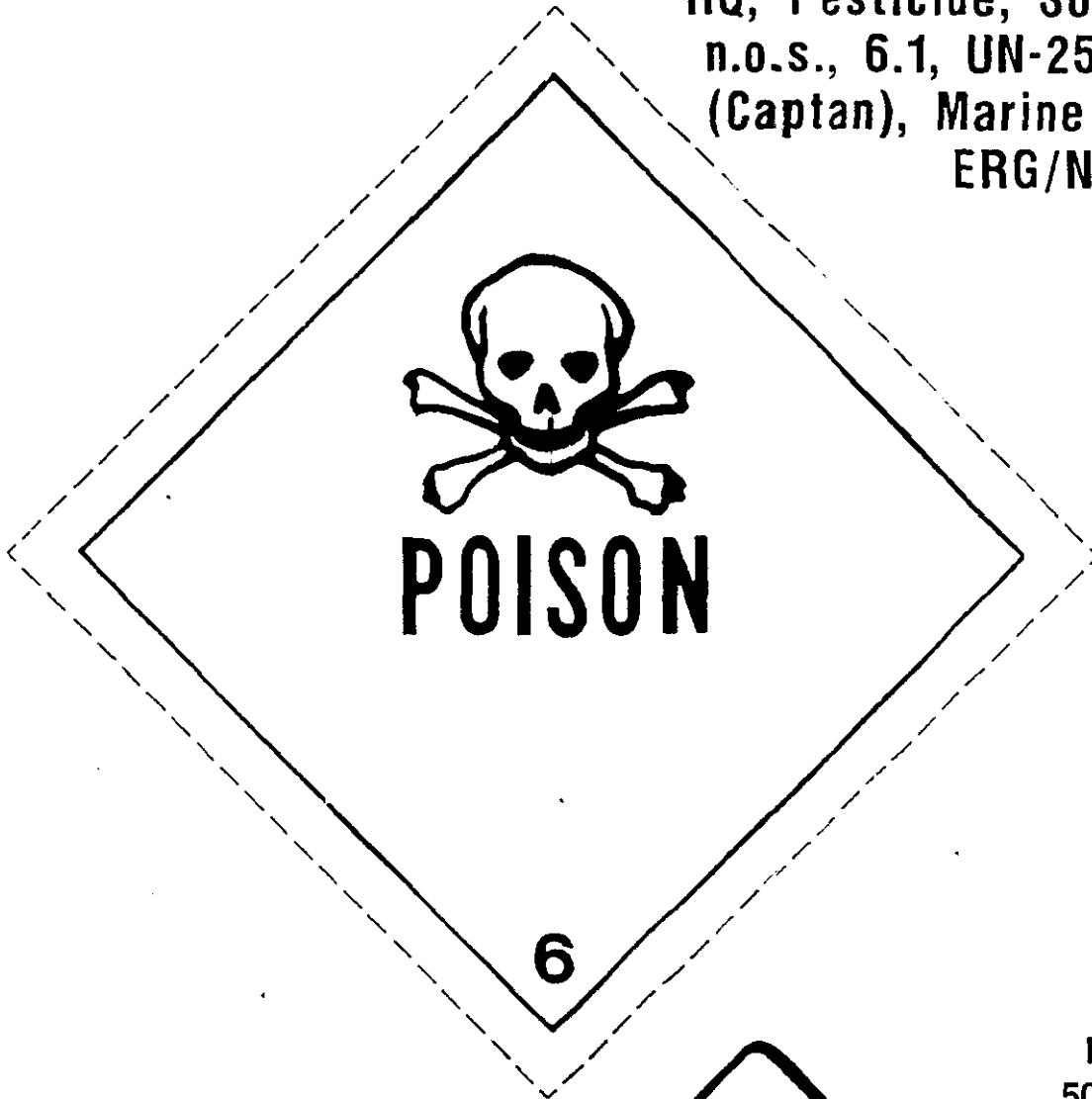

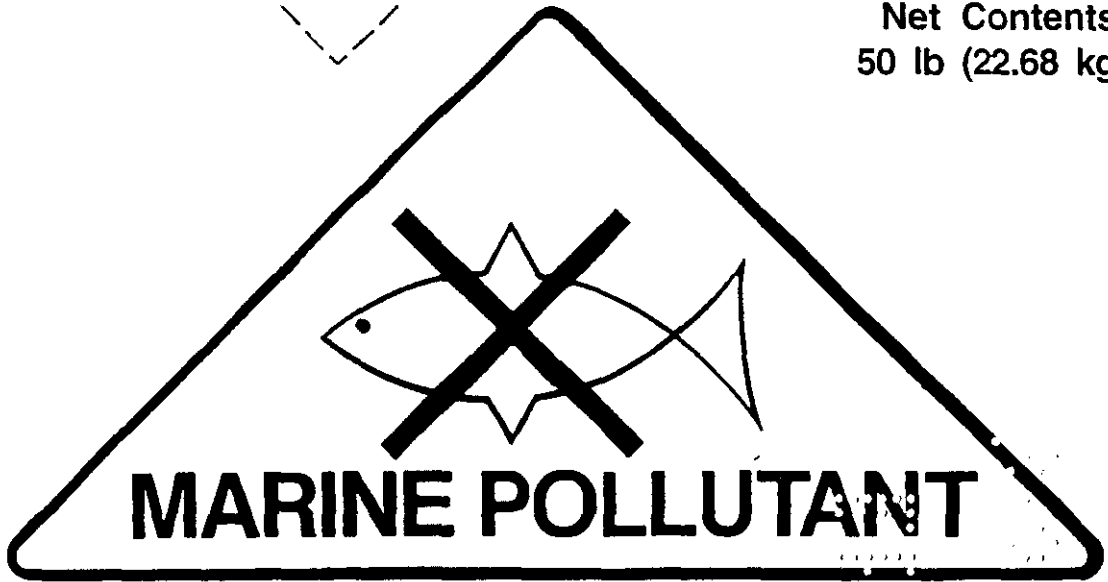
