The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

The following specific comments pertain to your WPS labeling submission concerning the product cited above:

Add the following User Safety Recommendation to the label in the location shown in Section A on Part I of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7: "Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."

Delete the crossed-out statements on your proposed label. They are redundant statements or phrases.

Malathion Wettable Powder per 100 gals. water. For control of woolly apple aphid and green apple aphid, use one or more applications, as needed, of spray containing 2 lbs. Malathion Powder per 100 gals. water. For control of rosy apple aphid use one or more applications of spray containing 2 1/2 lbs. Malathion Wettable Powder per 100 gals. of water.

PEARS: Spider mites, same directions as those for apples. For control of pear psylla on pears, make 1 or more applications as needed, of a spray containing 2 to 2 1/2 lbs. of Malathion Wettable Powder per 100 gals, of water, 1 tbsp. to 1 gal, water.

MAKE NO APPLICATIONS LATER THAN 21 DAYS BEFORE HARVEST ON APPLES OR PEARS.

For the control of black scale crawlers, soft brown scale and Monterey pine scale spray with 6 lbs. of Malathion Wettable Powder with 100 gals. water. 2 rounded tbsp. to 1 gal. of water.

TOMATOES: For the control of aphids and spider mites, make 1 or more applications, as needed of spray containing 2 lbs. Malathion Wettable Powder per 100 gals, of water. 1 tbsp. to 1 gal. water.

MAKE NO APPLICATION ON TOMATOES LATER THAN 10 DAYS BEFORE HARVEST.

DO NOT USE ON CUCUMBERS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
