Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of food or feed. Do not use on household pets or humans. Remove pets from area, and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until sprayed surfaces have dried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Birds feeding or drinking on treated area may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Repeat as necessary. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.
