ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. DREXAR WEED-AWAY is applied as a foliage spray for the control of most Brush, Grasses and Weeds. Use in and around flower beds, walks, driveways and around trees and shrubs. Use as a spot spray only to individual Weeds in lawns. Spraying on top destroys most problem Weeds and effectively edges Grass by killing the root system.

READ AND FOLLOW LABEL PRECAUTIONS AND DIRECTIONS.

APPLICATION: Adjust spray nozzle to stream or spray (turn to off when not in use). Hold sprayer close to Weed and spray to wet slightly; do not overspray. Some hard-to-kill Weeds and brush may need to be sprayed again in 4 weeks.

Note: When spraying Weeds, be careful not to spray foliage or green bark of plants or trees and blades or runners of desirable lawn grasses. Do not apply when rain is expected within 8 hours. Do not water within 24 hours. Do not allow children and pets in treated area until dry; this prevents tracking spray to desirable vegetation. Discoloration usually occurs in about 7 to 10 days and complete kill in 2 to 4 weeks. Treated areas can be reseeded or planted 7 days after application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. **PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Do not store near feed or food products. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
