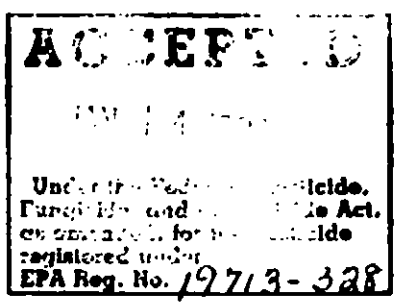

Products formulated from this product will require registration with the Environmental Protection Agency.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin, or inhaled. May cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

For use only in formulating other copper hydroxide products. Products formulated from this product will require registration with the Environmental Protection Agency.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Store in ventilated, cool area away from sources of heat and flame. Keep in tightly closed original container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
