On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration eligibility Documents, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4 (g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Registration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at anytime to maintain the registration of your product. with regards to labeling, you must make the labeling changes listed below:

- 1. The label must indicate "Net Contents" of the container and state the amount of product.
- 2. Based on the Acute Toxicology profile for this product you must include a heading of "First Aid" and the First Aid statements should read as follows:

FIRST AID

"IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by poison control center or doctor.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment

IF ON EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or a doctor for treatment advice."

3. The following statements should be placed near the First Aid Statements:

"In case of emergency call (insert toll-free emergency number)."

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment."

- 4. Your product is required to have a "Note to Physicians." This should be located directly below your "First Aid" Statement and should contain the following information:
 - Technical Information on symptomatology;
 - Use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
 - Medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
 - Company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice.
- 5. The "Human Precautionary Statements" must be revised to read as follows: "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction to some individuals.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Mixers and Handlers must wear:

- -long-sleeved shirt and pants
- -shoes and socks
- -chemical resistant gloves."
- 6. A "User Safety Requirements" statement must be added and should read as follows: "Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."
- 7. A "User Safety Recommendations" statement must be added to the label and should read as follows:
 Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.
 Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then was thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."
- Under the heading "Environmental Hazards", delete the statements: "Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not reuse empty Container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place."
- 9. Under the heading "Pesticide Disposal", delete the statements beginning with "Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal...nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance."

Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle	Horn Flies, Face Flies, Lice	HAND OUSTING: Apply approximately 2 oz. of dust by shaker can, rotary duster or by spoon to the upper portions of the back, neck and poll and to the face as an aid in control of face flies. Rub in lightly to carry the dust beneath the hair. Repeat as necessary. SELF TREATING DUST BAG: FORCED USE put RABEX LIVESTOCK DUST in cotton doth or durable bag or use pre-packed weather proof Cattle dust bag and hang in bam door exits or alleyways leading from animal buildings, salt or mineral blocks or watering holes. Protect doth or burlap bags from weather.
Swine	Lice	HAND DUSTING: Apply 3 to 4 cz. of dust by conventional hand or power duster to each animal with special attention given to the neck and around the ears. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once every 14 days. In severe infestations, both individual animals and bedding may be treated. One lb. of 3% dust should be applied per 150 sq. feet of bedding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store in areas of extreme heat or cold. Protect from moisture or extreme humidity.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic.
