The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, As Amended (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that:

1. The following information/items are submitted to the Agency before the subject product is released for shipment:

A. The establishment number of the manufacturing, formulation or repackaging product from which your subject product is derived.

B. The name and address of the entity from which the manufacturing, formulation or repackaging product was obtained, and

C. A copy of the bill of sale for the manufacturing, formulation or repackaging product from which your subject product is derived.

As specified in our previous letter of February 26, 1998, failure to provide these information/items within the specified time frame, may subject the registration to further regulatory action.

2. You submit one copy of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

If these condition are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

FIRST AID

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing dust or vapors. When handling the product, wear chemical-resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and long pants. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove and launder contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), NPDES permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Greenhouse Floral and Foliage Plants, Non-Food Uses On: Anthuriums, Cacti, Orchids, Roses, Poinsettia, Carnations and Chrysanthemum.
