The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, As Amended (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that:

1. You submit the information/items cited below to the Agency before the subject product is released for shipment. This condition was previously specified in our letters of February 26, 1998, and February 18, 1999 for the product.

A. The establishment number of the manufacturing, formulation or repackaging product from which your subject product is derived;

C. A copy of the bill of sale for the manufacturing, formulation or repackaging product from which your subject product is derived.
