

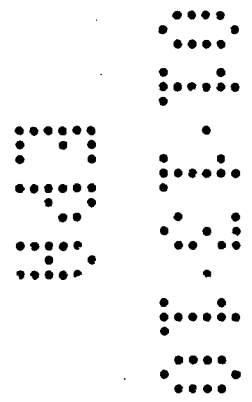

**When to Apply:** For best results, apply in the early morning or late afternoon when Ants are active. Applications made during the hottest part of the day or during prolonged hot or dry conditions may be ineffective due to Ants being deep within the nest. Treat mounds at the time of greatest foraging activity of the Ants (i.e., when soil temperatures are between 60° to 80°F). Try not to disturb the mounds while treating. Do not apply during heavy dew or just before a rain.

**INDIVIDUAL MOUND TREATMENT**

**Dry Treatment:** Sprinkle 2 teaspoonfuls of this product (dry powder) over each mound. DO NOT WATER IN.

**NOTE:** This method of treatment is usually preferred over the drench treatment method (See Drench Treatment) because it does not disturb the mound. This is important because unaffected Fire ants may relocate the mound to a new area nearby if mound is disturbed. One pound of this product applied as a dry powder treats up to 108 medium-sized mounds (1 to 2 feet in diameter).

**Drench Treatment:** Mix this product at the rate of 1 ounce in 5 gallons of water. Apply 1 gallon of mix to each mound area by sprinkling the mound until it is wet and treat a 4-foot diameter circle around the mound. One pound will treat approximately 80 medium-sized mounds.
