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

**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**WARNING:** May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe dust or vapors.

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Terrestrial non-domestic food uses on: Alfalfa, Alfalfa (seed only), Apples, Beans (Dry, Lima, Snap), Broccoli, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Celery, Chernes, Citrus (Grapefruit, Lemon, Orange, Tangerine), Collards, Cotton, Endive (Escarole), Field corn, Grapes, Kale, Lettuce, Melons, Mustard greens, Pears, Peas, Pecans, Peppers, Potatoes, Safflower, Sorghum (Milo), Soybeans, Spinach, Swiss chard, Tomatoes, Turnips and Wheat.

(2) Uses for which U.S. EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and

(3) Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements.

### FIRST AID

#### IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

#### IF IN EYES:

#### IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

#### IF INHALED:

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Antidote: Administer atropine sulfate in large doses; TWO (2) to FOUR (4) mg intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5- or 10-minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. 2-PAM chloride is a pharmacologic antidote and may be administered as an adjunct to, but not a substitute for atropine, which is a symptomatic and often lifesaving antidote. DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS. Dimethoate is a cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued absorption of the poison may occur and relapses have been reported after initial improvement. VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.
