


This product may be used only for the formulation of a herbicide for use on these terrestrial nonfood crops: Evergreen and Deciduous Trees and Shrubs, Ground Covers, Citrus nursery stock and young non-bearing Orange and Grapefruit groves, Herbaceous Plants, Pine Seedling Nurseries.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on this label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Open dumping is prohibited. Do not store this product near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides. Do not store near heat or open flame.
