- 3. Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store above 32°F in original container only unless it is damaged and requires to be replaced. In such case, clearly label contents. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed. If the contents are leaking or material is spilled, follow these steps:

- 1. Collect and place in suitable containers for disposal.
- 2. Wash area with water and soap to remove remaining pesticide.
- 3. Follow washing with clean water rinse.
- 4. Do not allow runoff to enter sewer or contaminate water supplies.
