(1) Crops including Alfalfa, Asparagus, Barley, Beans (all Dry and Fresh), Carrots, Celery, Chicory, Citrus (Bearing and Non-bearing), Cole crops, Collard, Corn, Cotton, Cottonwood trees grown for pulp, Crambe, Cucurbits, Durum, Eggplant, Flax, Grain sorghum (Milo), grapes, Guar, Hops, Kale, Kenaf, Lentils, Mustard, Nut trees, Okra, Onions, Peas, Peanuts, Pepper, Peppermint, Potatoes, Radish, Rapeseed (Canola), Safflower, Soybeans, Spearmint, Stone fruits, Sugar beet, Sugarcane, Sunflower, Tomatoes, Turnip greens, Wheat; (2) Ornamentals; (3) Turf and; (4) Noncropland.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Nonrefillable Container (rigid material; 5 gallons up to < 250 gallons): Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container one-fourth full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

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Refillable Container (≥ 250 gallons & Bulk): Refillable container. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container about 10% full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
