- 1. **Terrestrial food and feed crops uses** Alfalfa, mixed stands of Alfalfa and Forage grasses, Asparagus, Barley, Carrots, Com, Fallow, Garbanzo beans (Chickpeas), Forage grasses, Grasses grown for seed, Lentils, Peas, Potatoes, Sainfoin, Soybeans, Sugarcane, Timothy, Tomatoes and Wheat.
- Terrestrial non-food, non-domestic and feed crops uses Established Bermudagrass turf, Ornamental lawns and Turf (not residential), Non-agricultural uncultivated areas/soils, Recreational areas.
- 3. Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Nonrefillable Container (flexible-bag-all weights): Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Then offer for recycling if available or dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
