- 2) **Terrestrial Uses:** Seed crops (Alfalfa, Clover, Grain sorghum, Soybeans); Grapes (Non-bearing) and certain non-bearing trees, Vines, Small fruits and Vegetable crops; Areas around farms including Barrier strips, Equipment areas, Farmyards, Farm buildings, Fence lines, Fuel storage areas, Rights-of-way and non-flooded portions of Ditches, Lakes and Ponds around farms; Commercial, Landscape, Industrial, Recreational, Residential and Public areas including Commercial buildings, Electric utilities, Fence lines and Parkways, Manufacturing plants, Rail yards, Storage yards and edges and non-flooded portions of Ditches, Lakes and Ponds; Rights-of-way including Dividers and Medians, Highways, Pipelines, Public utility lines, Pumping stations, Railroads, Roads, Transformers stations and Substations; Also in commercial greenhouses and nurseries, Ornamental seed crops (Bulbs, Flowers, etc.), around Ornamental gardens, Patios, beneath Greenhouse benches, along Driveways and on or around Golf courses; Turf renovation (all Turf areas except commercial Sod farms); Dormant established Bermudagrass (non-food or feed crop).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container one-fourth full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling, if available, or dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.

Refillable Container (≥ 250 gallons & Bulk): Refillable container. Refill this container with Diquat Dibromide only. **DO NOT** reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container about 10% full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times. Offer for recycling, if available, or dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.
