The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Delete first "n" in "pyrindines" in ingredient statement.
 - b. Delete space after "tetramethyl" in ingredient statement.
 - c. Revise your "Storage and Disposal" statement as follows:

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets and outside of the home.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Crush, securely wrap in newspaper, and discard in trash.

- d. Under "Your Own Dog" change first sentence to read "...than a stray, it is...."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE -CATS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Never store container in the home. Use gloves for broadcasting or application of this product. Do not place material in piles. Product may be applied directly from container. If compacted, break material with a stick or screwdriver before application.

Do not apply directly to plants, flowers, or foliage (lawns excepted). Do not apply within one foot of plants or painted surfaces. Do not apply to DICHONDRA or unusual ground covers.

For use on LAWNS, AROUND HEDGES, TREES, SHRUBS, VINES, FLOWER and VEGETABLE GARDENS, and UNDER BUSHES.

AS A CAT REPELLENT TO PREVENT DIGGING:

Remove fecal material. Fill existing hole and hose down area to eliminate odors. Sprinkle REPEL™ evenly on the affected area at a rate of 1 lb per 55 sq. ft. Re-treat at least once per week until unwanted behavior stops.

Resume treatment if problem re-occurs.

YOUR OWN CAT:

When the problem involves your cat rather than a stray, it is necessary to train your pet to not use the area. It may be necessary to hold the pet's face a few inches from REPEL™ to reinforce that the area is out of bounds.
